1. What worked especially well for you with this lesson/project?

2. Any student responses/interactions that surprised motivated or inspired you?

3. What are your suggestions for improvement for this lesson/project?

Provide flowers for children to use for background of diorama...as an option to drawing a bone.

Kids can always use more time. They (those who weren't grossed out) wanted to find all of the bone pieces, so had to hurry and not think about placement in the diorama – not a bad thing necessarily, not sure how one would fix it.
