1. What worked especially well for you with this lesson/project?

Each bag of sorted shapes is meant to be a classroom "set". Simply pour them out onto a table and then let the students choose their own shapes.

Maybe streamline the directions? Might be hard to walk into the room and teach from the directions if you haven't seen it done – not sure about this.
